4. Photo Electoral Rolls:

The Photo Electoral Rolls would be printed at ERO/DEO offices using ECI's ERONET Printing Software. The Electoral Roll would be available by 24th November, 2019. Non photo rolls would be made available on CEO Karnataka website i.e. <https://www.ceokarnataka.kar.nic.in>. Voters may search their EPIC number or name using <http://electoralsearch.in> or Voter Helpline Android or iOS app.

5. Electors Photo Identity Cards (EPIC):

As instructed by ECI, plastic PVC coloured photo identity card is being issued to the newly enrolled electors (1,59,152) and the distribution of EPIC cards will be completed by 03.12.2019.

6. Photo Voter Slips (PVS):

85% of Voter slips containing details of Voter, polling station, BLO contact details, poll date and timings and voter guides are distributed to the electors. But, it is not an authorized document for identification of an elector to participate in the election process.

7. Alternative Documents:

The Election Commission of India, in its order no. 3/4/ID/2019/SDR/VOL.I dated 18th November 2019, directs that for the current bye-elections to 15 LACs, all electors who have been issued EPIC shall produce the EPIC for their identification at the polling stations before casting their votes. Those electors who are not able to produce the EPIC shall produce one of the following alternative photo Identity documents for establishing their identity –

- (i) Passport,
- (ii) Driving License,
- (iii) Service Identity Cards with photograph issued to employees by Central/State Govt./PSUs/Public Limited Companies,
- (iv) Passbooks with photograph issued by Bank/Post Office,
- (v) PAN Card,
- (vi) Smart Card issued by RGI under NPR,
- (vii) MNREGA Job Card,
- (viii) Health Insurance Smart Card issued under the scheme of Ministry of Labour,
- (ix) Pension document with photograph,
- (x) Official identity cards issued to MPs/MLAs/MLCs, and
- (xi) Aadhaar Card.

8. Indelible Ink:

The indelible ink would be applied on the Left Hand Forefinger for the Bye-Elections to 15 Legislative Constituencies to be held on 05.12.2019.

12. EVM-VVPAT :

The First Level Checking of EVM-VVPAT is completed in all the 11 districts and after FLC 8326BU (197%), 8186CU (196%) and 7876 VVPAT (185%) machines are available for the elections. The First randomization process is completed in all the districts and EVM-VVPAT is distributed to the assembly constituencies for the preparation and use in the elections. The Second randomization process is completed and EVM-VVPAT Prepared for the elections.

13. Measures to prevent impersonation of Absentee Voters:

BLOs will do a door to door survey to prepare a list of voters found absent from their place of residence. Similarly the names of dead, shifted shall also be added to the list. This ASD list will be given to the Presiding officers on the poll day. PROs are required to doubly check the identity of voters whose names are on the ADD list.

14. 48 Hours before the Poll :

a. Issuance of orders under 144 CrPc:

The District Magistrates of 15 Legislative Assembly Constituencies would issue orders under Section 144 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973 , as per ECI guidelines and it is specifically

clarified in the order passed that, this order does not restrict house-to-house visits during 48 hours in connection with door-to-door campaigning.

b. *Restriction on presence of political functionaries in a constituency after the campaign period is over:*

The Presence of the Political functionaries / party workers / procession – functionaries / campaign – functionaries etc., who have been brought from outside the constituency and who are not votes of the constituency, should not continue to remain present in the constituency after the campaign period is over i.e. from 6 PM on 03.12.2019.

c. *Excise Enforcement:*

Dry days have been declared in the districts where Elections are being held on 05.12.2019 (from 06.00 PM of 03.12.2019 to 12.00 midnight of 05.12.2019). This enforcement will be in force in the border up to 5 kms.

d. *Use of Loudspeaker:*

There is a restriction on use of loudspeakers during 48 hours.

e. *Guidelines for print media:*

"No Political party or Candidates or any other organization or any person shall publish any advertisement in the print media one day prior to the poll day (i.e., 04 Dec 2019) and on the day of poll (i.e., 05 December 2019) unless the content of the advertisement proposed to be published by the Political Parties, Candidates etc have been Pre-Certified by the MCMC committee at the State/District level as the case may be".

It is further clarified that for any political advertisement to be published in the print media in circulation in the State on 5th Dec needs pre-certification by the MCMC committee at the State/District level as the case may be.

In this regard, it is directed that all the Political parties who wish to publish advertisements in the Print Media one day prior to the poll day and on the day of poll (i.e., 5th December 2019) shall submit two self-attested copies of the proposed advertisement along with duly filled application in the prescribed Annexure- C format latest by 3rd December 2019 (for advertisements on 5th December 2019) to State pre-certification committee located at Office of Additional CEO, 2nd Floor, East Wing, Khanija Bhavan, Race Course Road, Bengaluru 01.

Any contesting candidate, who wishes to publish political advertisements in the Print Media on one day prior to the poll day and on the day of poll shall submit two self-attested copies of the proposed advertisement along with duly filled application in the prescribed Annexure C format latest by 3rd December 2019 (for advertisements on 5th December) to District Media Certification and Monitoring Committee located at Deputy Commissioner office of the respective district.

All the print media whether at local, district, state or at national level shall not print any political advertisement relating to Elections conducted in Karnataka without pre-certification from the respective MCMC committees.

f. *Guidelines for Electronic Media including social media:*

"The section 126 of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 prohibits displaying any election matter, inter alia of television, Cinematograph or similar apparatus during the period of 48 hours ending with the hour fixed for conclusion of poll in a constituency. The expression "election matter" means any matter intended or calculated to influence or effect the result of an election. Any person who contravenes this provision shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years or with fines or with both"

Hence TV/Radio Channels, Cable Networks and all Digital media should ensure that the content of the Programmes telecast/broadcast/displayed by them during the period of 48 hours referred to above do not contain any material, including views/appeal by panel lists/participants that may be construed as promoting/prejudicing the prospects of any political party or candidate or influencing the result of election. This shall among other things include display of results of any opinion poll and of standard debates, analysis, visuals and sound bytes.

g. Exit Polls and Opinion Polls:

Attention is also invited to Section 126 A of RP Act, 1951 which prohibits conduct of Exit poll and dissemination of their results by means of print or electronic media or dissemination in any other manner whatsoever.

It is further clarified that under Section 126 (l) (B) of the RP Act, displaying any election matter including results of any opinion poll or any other poll survey in any electronic media would be prohibited during the period of 48 hrs ending with the hours fixed for conclusion of poll in the respective polling areas in connection with aforesaid General Elections.

h. Silence Period.

The silence period of 48 hrs may be on from 6.00 P.M 03-12-2019 in 15 constituencies going to poll on 5th December 2019. In this scenario, there should not be any direct or indirect reference amounting to soliciting support for parties or candidates in the constituencies observing the silence period. During the silence period Star Campaigners and other political leaders should refrain from addressing the media by way of press conferences and giving interviews on election matters.

The schedule for Bye Election to Assembly Constituencies has been announced on 27-09-2019. Poll in Karnataka is scheduled to be held on 05-12-2019. Hence, all the electronic media and digital media are directed to adhere to the above directions from 6 pm of 03-12-2019 to 6.30 pm of 05-12-2019.

16. Welfare measures, including health, for polling personnel and voters.

The DEOs have been instructed to have separate review on the subject, identifying the concern and asked to take advance measures to address facilitation.

Nodal officers for welfare in the district will coordinate and supervise the polling personnel welfare measures.
